Inhalation anthrax starts in chest lymph nodes & spreads through the body ultimately causing severe breathing problems & shock

Inhalation anthrax symptoms:
fever/chills/shortness of
breath/confusion/dizziness/cough/nausea/headache/sweats/fatigue/aches #EventHashtag

Inhalation anthrax is considered to be the most deadly form of anthrax

W/o treatment, about 10-15% of patients w/ inhalation anthrax survive. But w/ aggressive treatment about 55% of patients survive

Inhalation anthrax starts in the chest & spreads through the body, ultimately causing severe breathing problems & shock. Symptoms include fever, chills, shortness of breath, confusion, dizziness, cough, nausea, headache, sweats, fatigue, & body aches.

Cutaneous anthrax is most common on the head, neck, forearms, and hands

Without treatment up to 20% of people with cutaneous anthrax may die. But with proper treatment almost all patients survive

Gastrointestinal (GI) anthrax occurs when a person eats/drinks anthrax spores. Symptoms incl. nausea/loss of appetite/diarrhea

W/o treatment over 50% of gastrointestinal anthrax patients die. But, w/ proper treatment 60% survive <http://1.usa.gov/MLIs0C> #EventHashtag

Other GI anthrax symptoms: fever/chills/neck swelling/sore throat/painful

Symptoms of gastrointestinal anthrax include: nausea, loss of appetite/bloody diarrhea/fever/chills/neck swelling/sore throat/painful swallowing/hoarseness, (bloody) vomiting/headache/red face/red

swallowing/hoarseness/vomiting/bloody vomiting #EventHashtag

Additional GI anthrax symptoms: bloody diarrhea/headache/red face/red eyes/stomach pain/ fainting/abdominal swelling #EventHashtag

Transmission	<p>Anthrax isn't known to spread from person to person so there is no need to avoid contact with others http://1.usa.gov/1puSPO4 #EventHashtag</p>	<p>Anthrax isn't known to spread from person to person, so people don't have to avoid contact with others and infected people do not need to be isolated.</p>

Doctors choose the best antibiotics for treating anthrax & for the patient based on medical history <http://1.usa.gov/1caUOvV> #EventHashtag

(1 of 2) Anthrax spores typically take 1-6 days to activate (cause illness) but some spores can take up to 60 days #EventHashtag

(2 of 2) B/c spores can take up to 60 days to activate, people who are exposed to anthrax must take antibiotics for 60 days #EventHashtag

Antibiotics can prevent anthrax from developing in those who were exposed but haven't had symptoms <http://1.usa.gov/1q32hHn> #EventHashtag

A vaccine exists to prevent anthrax, but it is not normally recommended for the general public <http://1.usa.gov/1q32hHn> #EventHashtag

The vaccine may be given to people who have been exposed to anthrax in this current situation <http://1.usa.gov/1q32hHn> #EventHashtag

Vaccine treatment includes 3 shots over 4 weeks + a 60-day course of antibiotics to prevent

There are treatments for anthrax, and public health authorities are working to get these treatments to the people who need them. There are enough treatments for everyone who needs them.

Anthrax spores typically take 1 to 6 days to be activated (cause illness) but some spores can remain inside the body & take up to 60 days or more. Therefore, people who have been exposed to anthrax must take antibiotics for 60 days.
